Spiky Blue forms very attractive 6-10 inch blue-green cushions with silvery plumes with purple anthers from June to August. In autumn the foliage takes on an appealing turquoise and mauve tones. Prefers full sun and moderate water and its mounding forms are perfect for mass plantings.

Spiky tufts of blue/grey foliage make great edging plants or fun statements in containers. Avoid extremes in both temperature and moisture. Cut back foliage in the Spring to encourage new coloured grass each year.

Plant Type Grass

Mature Size Height: 25cm ; Spread: 20cm

Soil Requirements Prefers well-drained soils that contain a little lime.

Exposure Full sun

Bloom Period/Bloom Desc. Seed heads from June to September.

Foliage Spiky tufts of blue to grey foliage. As it ages it becomes an attractive reddish-green.
